Sub: VCI Elections,2009 - photo-copies of Declaration papers(Form-III) sought under RTI Act - CPIO violated the RTI Act by not providing such information and documents-strict implementation of order of High Court of A.P. in WP No.27725/2010 for not destroying the Declaration papers-requested-regarding.

Ref: 1) My application Dt.09.12.2010 under RTI Act,2005.

2) Order Dt.19.11.2010 of Hon' ble High Court of A.P. in W.P. No.27725/2010.

With reference to the subject and reference cited, I am herewith submit the following for your kind perusal:

- 1) I am one of the contestant in VCI election-2009 and also the petitioner in WP No.27725/2010 of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh
- 2) I was present during the counting of votes and I observed that few hundreds of Declaration Forms(Form-III),which were accompanied with Voting Paper Covers, from different states of the country, were containing similar kind of hand writing as if all filled by only one individual, which is quite unusual. Further, it was also observed that the most of the Declaration Forms (Form-III) were not filled completely and also seems that most of them were attested with fake signatures of the electors confirming the contentions of my W.P.
- 3) In view of my personal observations, I sought certain information and photo-copies of all the Declaration Forms(Form-III) from Sri A.K.Barua,Director(Adm) & CPIO,Dept.of AHD&F,Ministry of Agriculture, Krishi Bhavan,New Delhi under the Right to Information


Act, 2005 vide my application Dt.09.12.2010 along with the required fee but I have not received any reply from CPIO.

- 4) My appeal is still pending before the Appellant Authority, D.A.H.D & F under RTI Act, 2005
- 5) As per the information received from the reliable sources, one of the official acting as Assistant Returning Officer from the day one to till now, who has misutilized his authority by handing-over few thousands of returned/undelivered Ballot Paper covers to his team of contestants, at present planning to annihilate the evidence material of fraud pertaining to the election keeping in view of my application under RTI Act and court case by moving the proposals before the concerned authorities of the Ministry for destruction of all the material papers pertaining to VCI Election-2009 including Declaration Papers.
- 6) Therefore, I would like to remind the kind officer, the order dated 19.11.2010 in W.P.No.27725/2010 of Hon'ble High Court of A.P. stating ***"However, the 2nd respondent shall not destroy the declaration papers in Form III by all the electors."***

Hence, I request the kind officer to protect all the Declaration papers (Form III) of VCI election, 2009 by strict implementation of the order dated 19.11.2010 of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P.No.27725/2010.

This is for favor of necessary action.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. nil dated 28.3.2011 addressed to Secretary (ADF) on the subject cited above. The issues reflected in your letter have been examined in the Department and the reply on each point is as follows:-

- a) Regarding point No. 2 related to the genuineness/fakeness of signature (handwriting) on Declaration Forms (Form-III), it is stated that such type of 184 number objections were raised during counting and were addressed by Returning Officer.
- b) Reply to the appeal pending before the Appellant Authority, DAHD&F under RTI Act, 2005 has already been sent to you vide this department's letter dated 31.3.2011. Further, information from CPIO level as desired by you under RTI, have also been sent vide letter dated 16th January, 2011 by Dr. Vijay Kumar. A copy of the said reply was also sent to you vide this department's letter of even number dated 4th February, 2011, from the level of Joint Commissioner of the Department (copy enclosed) .
- c) Regarding the safety of the declaration form (Form III) accompanied with voting paper cover, it is to inform you that all the declaration paper (Form III) and other relevant documents have been sealed by Returning Officer in presence of AROs after counting them and after completion of election process on 27th November, 2010 for the election of 11 members . Further, all these documents have also been kept in sealed, safe and protected conditions as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in WP No. 27725/2010 on 19.11.2010.


